Minutes

Call to Order/Announcements:

Brent called the meeting to order at 5:33 PM.

Meeting Minutes

1. Approval of June Minutes

The Committee reviewed the minutes. Benaiah moves to adopt the amended June minutes. Dave seconds, unanimous approval.

1. Vice Chair

2. City Council Representation on UTC

The feedback Jason received indicated that it would be recommended for City Council to abstain from any items that may go to council for vote or approval. Cody and Jason agreed that this would be good practice for Council Representatives moving forward.

Brent had a question regarding the number of representatives on the committee. The bylaws state that the committee should consist of 7 to 9 members, but with 2 City Council representatives, the total comes to 10. Brent also asked about the Chair's responsibility of ex-officio representation on subcommittees. There was further discussion and Eric stated that he would get legal clarification.

Updates

1. Walk Audit Subcommittee

Benaiah gave an update on the proposed routes near CMU, 12th and North area.

Potential dates of August 26th, September 23rd, and September 30th were identified. September 30th was identified as the target date.

Other Business

Cody brought up the conversation of bike parking. It would be good to come up with funds to help provide bike parking for existing locations that need it. This could be a council level decision but could be good to discuss with UTC and provide a recommendation to council. Brent supports this idea.
